With features including a fast 90 DPM scan rate, highest MICR accuracy in its class and high-quality imager, the new version of

CaptureOne is ideal for branch back counter check processing, commercial accounts windows and high-volume Remote Deposit Capture (RDC) applications where speed, accuracy and maximum throughput are essential to workflow efficiency.

Epson's CaptureOne 90 DPM scanner, as well as its 30 and 60 DPM models, are expressly designed to minimize MICR misreads and non-conforming images—eliminating the manual intervention required to reprocess misread checks. With less reliable desktop scanners, the result is often a higher number of unreadable items due to MICR misreads, substitution errors or jamming. These unreadable items effectively lower average check processing speed and throughput. With CaptureOne's superior MICR accuracy and image quality, check misreads rarely ever occur, resulting in the lowest possible number of misread checks and, ultimately, the highest overall throughput.

“A fast scanner is only as good as its check processing accuracy. Too many misreads and you're losing productivity,” said Bud Weist, vice president of sales and marketing, Epson System Device Group. “We've designed the CaptureOne product to deliver not only check processing speed, but high MICR accuracy and high overall throughput. Our philosophy is that throughput is the only true measure of performance, so when you have high workflow efficiency, you can directly translate that to high ROI.”

Other features of the CaptureOne 90 DPM model include clear electronic endorsements for 100% legibility, a double check detector that virtually eliminates double check feeding and a built-in franker that prints a static message on checks to prevent double processing. In addition to being the only check scanner available with a two-year warranty, Epson provides overnight replacement options to minimize downtime.
